Course description

This course is designed primarily for students who possess *no prior knowledge* of Hungarian and who are enrolled in the Erasmus Program or other foreign exchange programs at the University of Sopron. As foreign language acquisition is a fundamental element of the Erasmus Program and other exchange programs, this course seeks to address this need and help students gain basic Hungarian language skills. Though the university offers German and English language courses, many foreign exchange students have shown interest in learning Hungarian. This course seeks to address this interest and provide opportunities that allow students to gain basic Hungarian language skills.

Topics

Starting from the assumption that students have *no previous experience* with Hungarian, the course will focus on the acquisition of basic grammatical and lexical skills, the development of skills related to everyday speech topics, and the exploration of Hungarian geography, social sciences, history, and culture. Topics covered by the course include: meeting people; friends and family; residences and accommodation; time and schedules; travel; current events; and leisure. Grammar and vocabulary will focus on parts of speech, verb tenses, verb conjugation, subjective case, questions, numerals, and the possessive case.
