Course description

This course is designed primarily for Erasmus students and other exchange students at the University of Sopron who have *rudimentary knowledge* of the Hungarian language or who have completed Hungarian for Beginners I. As foreign language acquisition is a fundamental element of the Erasmus program and other exchange programs, this course seeks to address this need and help students develop their Hungarian language skills. Though the university offers German and English language courses, many Erasmus and other exchange students have shown interest in learning Hungarian. *This course seeks to address this interest and provide opportunities to allow students to improve their basic Hungarian language skills.*

Topics

Starting from the assumption that students have completed Hungarian for Beginners I or possess some basic knowledge of Hungarian, the course will focus on the further development of basic grammatical and lexical skills, the development of speech skills related to everyday speech topics, and the exploration of Hungarian geography, social sciences, history, and culture. Material covered by the course includes: employment and the workplace; money and finances; meeting people; friends and family; residences and accommodation; schedules; telling time; travel; current events; and leisure time. Grammar and vocabulary will focus on further development of parts of speech, verb tenses, verb conjugation, subjective case, questions, numerals, and the possessive case.
